I hope to create the type of home that is warm and welcoming and will be the hang out spot for the kids and their friends as they grow up.



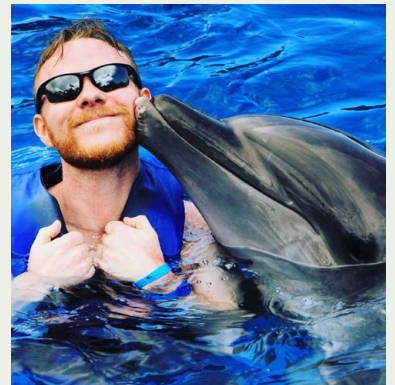
MY FAVORITE ADVENTURES

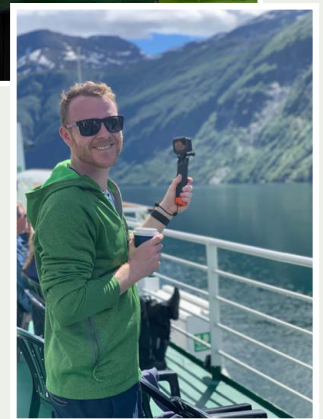
