ADOPTION IN OUR LIFE

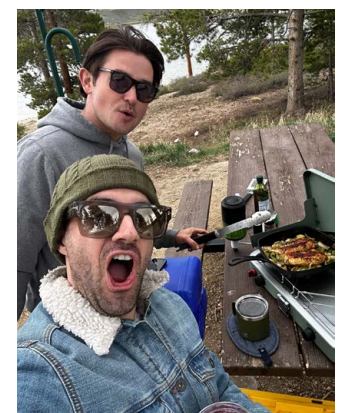

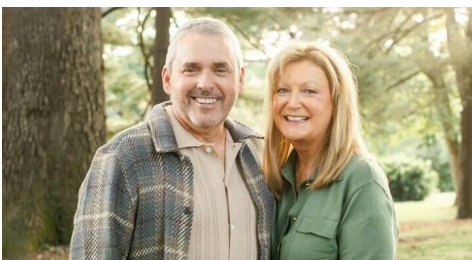
